

Remember Us Behaviour Policy



It is the policy of Remember Us that no inappropriate behaviour should be permitted at any time while the member is at a Remember Us club night/day/overnight trip.

- Remember Us provides a secure social environment for all members/ vulnerable adults to learn, make friends and have fun.
- It also provides an opportunity to develop social and life skills, self-esteem and a good quality of life.
- We are primarily a social club and in view of this and of the trust placed by Parents/Guardians on volunteers - No inappropriate behaviour such as bullying, violence, sarcasm, name-calling, 'slagging', and other forms of scapegoating, favouring some to the exclusion of others, abusive language or gestures or any form of punishment – physical, emotional, psychological, will be permitted at any time.

Members engaged in such behaviours will be asked to stop and may be asked to take time out. Inappropriate behaviours will also be reported to parents/carers by the group leader.

- The Leader/Volunteer has the discretion to determine what is deemed to be inappropriate behaviour and to identify and deal with such behaviour as per their volunteer induction training.
