GDPR Compliance



General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) significantly increases the obligations and responsibilities for organisations such as Remember Us in how we collect, use and protect personal data. At the center of the new law is the requirement for organisations and businesses to be fully transparent about how they are using and safeguarding personal data, and to be able to demonstrate accountability for their data processing activities. Remember Us collects and stores data you provide us, we act as a Data Controller so we can provide our services and run the organisation efficiently.

Why do we collect and store your personal information?

We need to collect and store your personal information in order to provide relevant services, maintain communications with you, and respond to queries. We send you information about Remember Us activities and events. We may also contact you for administration purposes.

How do we collect personal information?

Information is collected using a variety of methods. You will be asked to provide your personal information when joining Remember Us, making a donation, or requesting information or updates through our website, e-mail, direct mail or telephone communications. This information is vital in allowing provide best care and attention to everyone availing of and supporting our services.

What do we collect?

Remember Us does not collect any personal information other than information that is knowingly and willingly given. This personal data includes a record of your interactions with us and is stored in-house on our database to enable us to provide our services. Through our interaction with you we may gather a range of contact details including emails, mobile, postal address and landline numbers.

Do we share your information?

We respect your privacy and will not sell or give your details to other organisations for marketing purposes.

How can I be sure my privacy is protected?

Remember Us will always endeavour to protect your data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access or disclosure, alteration or destruction. We are committed to investing in technology to provide security for your information, including working with leading suppliers of secure payment services.

Retention of personal information

In the main personal information obtained will be retained for 6 years after the last contact with Remember Us.

Your Rights

You have a number of rights in relation to the personal information which is held about you, including:

- The right to see the personal information Foo and to be provided with the details regarding the processing on it;
- The right to have the personal information rectified if it is inaccurate or incomplete;
- The right to request that the personal information is erased, object to it being processed or request that the processing is restricted;
- The right to complain to the data protection commission, which may be contacted via its website at www.dataprotection.ie

If you wish to avail of these rights, a request must be submitted in writing to the Data Protection Officer of Remember Us. In order to protect your privacy, you may be asked to provide suitable proof of identification before the DPO can process your request.
